## 16<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Editorial Board of the IPCC Emission Factor Database (EFDB) 13-16 November 2018 Buenos Aires, Argentina

## Summary of the meeting

The key objectives of the meeting were to consider data proposals for inclusion into the EFDB and discuss how to improve and enhance the EFDB including its population and usefulness. The meeting was held in parallel with the 16<sup>th</sup> Expert Meeting on Data (16<sup>th</sup> Data Meeting) for the EFDB which was focused on data for Land Use, Land-Use Change and Forestry (LULUCF) and Waste sectors. The meetings were hosted by Government of Argentina and Faculty of Law of the University of Buenos Aires and organised by the Technical Support Unit (TSU) of the IPCC Task Force on National Greenhouse Gas Inventories (TFI). Amit Garg (India) and Kristina Saarinen (Finland) were elected as Co-chairs of Editorial Board for 2018-2021. Dario Gomez (Argentina), TFB member served as acting Co-chair during the meeting in the absence of Amit Garg. TFI Co-chairs expressed their gratitude for accepting this role. Agenda of the meeting (approved as amended) is attached.

The Editorial Board considered and discussed several issues in particular:

- considered data proposals including data submitted by experts and participants of the 16<sup>th</sup> Data Meeting as well as data proposals by TSU. Total 310 data were accepted for inclusion into the EFDB and the accepted data include new data for the areas/categories identified in the technical assessment of the IPCC Inventory Guidelines implemented by the IPCC TFI in 2015-2016.
- considered and agreed on the draft text on procedure for election of Editorial Board Co-chairs to be included in Terms of Reference of the Editorial Board.
- revisited the "robustness" criteria including the term "accepted uncertainty" and made some edits in corresponding sections.

At the closing plenary, TFI Co-Chairs notified the participants of four outgoing members of the Editorial Board and thanked them for their contribution. TFI Co-Chairs extended appreciation to Government of Argentina and Faculty of Law of the University of Buenos Aires for hosting these meetings, and also to Government of Switzerland for financial contribution.

The meeting was closed by the IPCC TFI Co-Chairs thanking all participants and Government of Argentina and Faculty of Law of the University of Buenos Aires for hosting the meetings and excellent arrangements.
