

Task Force on National Greenhouse Gas Inventories (TFI)

20th Meeting of the Editorial Board of the IPCC Emission Factor Database (EFDB)
28 June-1 July 2022
Bilbao, Spain

Summary of the meeting

The 20th Meeting of the Editorial Board (EB20) was held on 28 June-1 July 2022 in Bilbao, Spain (inperson meeting with virtual participation). The meeting was attended by Editorial Board members (31 out of 36), Co-Chairs of the IPCC Task Force on National Greenhouse Gas Inventories (TFI) and Technical Support Unit (TSU) of the TFI. The objectives of the EB20 were, among others:

- To discuss how to ensure consistent application of data evaluation criteria over time and among sectors
- · To evaluate outstanding and new data proposals
- To discuss how to improve the EFDB (e.g., enhancement of the population, functionality)

Agenda of the meeting is attached as adopted.

The EB20 was held in parallel with the Joint 19th and 20th Expert Meeting on Data (JDM 19&20) which was focused on data for Energy, Industrial Processes and Product Use (IPPU), Agriculture, Land Use, Land-Use Change and Forestry (LULUCF) and Waste sectors for inclusion into the EFDB. The JDM19&20 was attended by 23 experts/data providers and Editorial Board members.

The Editorial Board:

- considered data proposals including those submitted by experts/participants of the JDM19&20.
 Total 639 data were accepted for inclusion into the EFDB and 8 data for publication on the "Extra page" at the EFDB website.
- discussed about enhancement and possible future development of the EFDB including suggestions/proposals on the enhancement of population, improvement of user interface and how to ensure consistent application of data evaluation criteria.

The EB20 was closed by the IPCC TFI Co-Chairs thanking all participants of the meeting and TSU.

The TFI extends its appreciation to the Basque Center for Climate Change for hosting the EB20 as well as the JDM19&20, and to the government of Spain as well as the Basque country government for their support.
