UNITED NATIONS FRAMEWORK CONVENTION ON CLIMATE CHANGE

Article 4

COMMITMENTS

- 1. All Parties, taking into account their common but differentiated responsibilities and their specific national and regional development priorities, objectives and circumstances, shall:
- (a) Develop, periodically update, publish and make available to the Conference of the Parties, in accordance with Article 12, national inventories of anthropogenic emissions by sources and removals by sinks of all greenhouse gases not controlled by the Montreal Protocol, using comparable methodologies to be agreed upon by the Conference of the Parties;

IPCC CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM

General

- Systematic classification
- Delineates system boundaries
- Facilitates transparent estimation
- Reporting IPCC tables



EMISSIONS ESTIMATION

Specific Sectoral Guidance

- Simplified estimation
- Complex estimation
- Quality assurance/control
- Uncertainties



Decision 5/CMA.3 mandates the UNFCCC to develop reporting tools for the electronic reporting of the tables and formats, including common reporting tables (CRT) for GHG inventory reporting.
